SOUTH BEND, Indiana – May 15, 2019 – The Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians and Four Winds® Casinos are pleased to outline the schedule of events for the 2019 Four Winds Invitational. The announcement was made today at the tournament's Sponsor and Media Day, held at Blackthorn Golf Club in South Bend, Ind.

The Four Winds Invitational is part of the Symetra® Tour – Road to the LPGA® and takes place Friday, June 7 through Sunday, June 9 at Blackthorn.

Included in the scheduled events are three separate 18-hole Pro-Ams, which pair professional golfers with amateurs. Other highlights include a 9-hole Daddy/Daughter tournament; Grapes on the Green, a food and wine tasting event; and Women's Golf Clinic 101. The main event, the Four Winds Invitational Tournament, begins on Friday, June 7 at 7:30 a.m. Registration is required for all special events. The main tournament admission is free courtesy of Martin's Super Markets.

The LPGA Symetra Tour brings female golfers from over 30 countries to compete throughout the year to become the next generation of professional golfers. At the end of the Symetra tour, the top 10 money winners "graduate" to become members of the national LPGA tour.

"It's important to point out how fortunate we are as a community to host such a prestigious LPGA event. Ask any of the professional players and they will tell you that the Four Winds Invitational is among the best tournaments on the LPGA's Symetra Tour each year," said Tim Firestone, Owner and General Manager of Blackthorn Golf Club. "An event of this significance simply could not happen without the commitment and support of the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians."

The Pokagon Band's ten-county service area includes four counties in Southwestern Michigan and six in Northern Indiana.
