The Pokagon Band's ten-county service area includes four counties in Southwestern Michigan and six in Northern Indiana. In 2007, it opened Four Winds Casino Resort in New Buffalo, Mich., followed by Four Winds Hartford in 2011, Four Winds Dowagiac in 2013 and Four Winds South Bend in January 2018.
