Great White is best known for their Grammy® nominated Best Hard Rock Performance hit, "Once Bitten, Twice Shy." To experience their hits live in concert – "Rock Me," "Mista Bone," "Save Your Love," "House of Broken Love," and "Lady Red Light"—is to ride an emotional wave of sultry connections, arousing lyrics, and an all-out marathon of hard-hitting orchestrations.
